Background

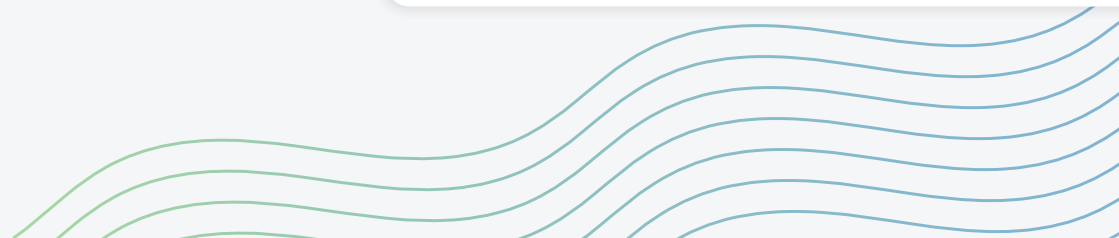
As a provider of comprehensive technology-powered solutions for students with unique learning challenges, n2y continuously strives to innovate by offering complete, differentiated core instructional products tailored to student needs.

Seeking to serve as many students as possible, n2y set out to launch a new education product, Inspire, to serve grades K-5 Math and ELA students of varying learning abilities. The goal was for Inspire to deliver skill-based intervention to close learning gaps through adaptive, personalized, and enhanced course experiences. However, n2y needed a long-term partner that could quickly scale and support the need for end-to-end content development, animations, and course design. LearningMate's technical and subject matter expertise, ability to scale,

and shared philosophy of supporting student achievement and empowering students made the partnership a perfect fit.

The Solution

First, LearningMate consulted with n2y and outlined the processes, checklists, and guidelines necessary for a successful project. Then, LearningMate's content team thoroughly researched strategies taught in the courses, as vetted by n2y's team, and determined how content should be enhanced with customized images, interactivities, and gamified activities.

Next, LearningMate developed K-5 Math and ELA content and end-to-end courses for students with mild to moderate cognitive and intellectual disabilities on n2y's proprietary LMS. This development allowed teacher-facing and student-facing content to be created in "iDocs" while assessment questions were developed in the "builder." LearningMate's custom digital content solution was designed to provide students with adaptive and differentiated levels of instruction during learning and assessments. Course design included carefully developing learning assets for various school settings, such as one-on-one, small groups, remote, and in-class learning

environments, to provide a holistic experience for students, teachers, and parents.



LearningMate continues to support the growth of n2y's Inspire through the development of digital courses, media, and assessments. Today, n2y has received 20 courses and 3,426 assessment questions in 24 months.

Impact & Outcomes

Leveraging LearningMate's experience in developing end-to-end courses for both below and above-grade-level students with differing abilities, n2y received 20 courses containing 5,040 iDocs and 1,512 assessment questions in 24 months.
